The 1855 classification only took into consideration 61 different chateaux from the Medoc, with one exception, Chateau Haut Brion from what was then known as Graves before it changed to Pessac Leognan.

Wine Classifications - USA Wines classification USA Wines classification Wine was produced in the USA for the first time in 1562 by French Huguenot settlers in Florida. It was made from a local grape variety. Classification of Wine - Wine Categories Regional wine classification were introduced to monitor the state and authenticity of wines created at a specific locations (estates and vineyards) in the world. The first of those laws was introduced in 1855s "Bordeaux Wine Official Classification" which catalogued all best wines created in their Bordeaux region. Wine Classifications - French Wines classification Beaujolais classification Beaujolais too is part of the Bourgogne region, but it produces very different wines and also has its own classification system. Beaujolais is produced in over 90 villages and has 12 different appellations. Between a third and half of the wines produced are sold annually as Beaujolais Nouveau.

WINE CLASSIFICATIONS - Edinformatics Regional wine classifications. Many Regional wine classifications exist as part of tradition or appellation law. The most common of these is based on vineyard sites and include the Bordeaux Wine Official Classification of 1855, though some regions classify their wines based on the style like the German wine classification system.
